



Jan Lexell, MD PhD

Professor of Rehabilitation Medicine and Chairman of the Division of Rehabilitation Medicine in the Department of Clinical Sciences, Lund at Lund University, Lund, Sweden.

Since 2003 he is Medical Director for the Post-polio clinic in the Department of Rehabilitation Medicine at Skåne University Hospital, Lund, Sweden, one of the main post-polio clinics in Sweden and one of the largest rehabilitation medicine departments in Scandinavia, since 1996 an internationally accredited (CARF) rehabilitation facility specialised in neurological rehabilitation and pain management.

Dr. Lexell is board certified (Sweden) in neurology and rehabilitation medicine, and since 2000 member of the American Academy of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.

Currently he is scientific secretary of the Swedish Society of Rehabilitation Medicine and member of the Medical Committee, The Swedish Sports Organization for the disabled and the Swedish Paralympic Committee (NPC Sweden).

His main research interests include muscle physiology and muscle morphology, muscle strength and fatigue, and disability assessments and rehabilitation interventions following post-polio, brain injury, stroke, chronic neurological disorders and spinal cord injury.

He has published over 100 original articles, reviews and book chapters.
